

## **Freedom Support Act 1992**

(aka Freedom for Russia and Emerging Eurasian Democracies and Open Markets Support Act of 1992)

### **Provisions**

Title I: General Provisions - Directs the President to designate a coordinator within the Department of State to be responsible for coordinating assistance to the independent states of the former Soviet Union (excluding Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania). Requires the coordinator to report to the Congress on the overall assistance and economic cooperation strategy for the independent states.

- 7/2/1992* Passed/agreed to in Senate: Passed Senate with amendments by Yea-Nay Vote. 76-20. Record Vote No: 148.
- 8/6/1992* Passed/agreed to in House: On passage Passed without objection.
- 9/16/1992* Resolving differences -- Senate actions: Senate disagreed to the House amendments by Voice Vote.
- 10/1/1992* Conference report H. Rept. 102-964 filed.
- 10/1/1992* Conference report agreed to in Senate: Senate agreed to conference report by Voice Vote.
- 10/3/1992* Conference report agreed to in House: On agreeing to the conference report Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 164 (Roll no. 462).
